POSITION SUMMARY:

The Animal Care and Adoption Specialist is responsible for working with the public to match the appropriate companion animals with potential guardians. This position is also responsible for the day-to-day care of the shelter cats and dogs, including medicating, socializing, monitoring for behavioral or medical issues, and supervising volunteers in general animal care. The Animal Care and Adoption Specialist is also responsible for helping to maintain a clean, healthy environment for our animals and visitors.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Have a desire to make a positive difference in the lives of animals
- Customer service experience and strong interpersonal skills
- Ability to work with a diverse group of individuals, including staff, volunteers and customers

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide counseling to potential adopters to match them to appropriate cat or dog, including general animal care, introduction to specific animals, and guidance in Homeward Pet's adoption process
- Supervise and work with volunteer crews during morning and evening animal care shifts. Help train, mentor, and ensure that policies and procedures are followed in the care of Homeward Pet's cats and dogs
- Provide direct animal care to shelter animals, including medicating, rehab, walks, socialization, and monitor for medical or behavioral issues
- Clean kennels and common areas of the shelter, do laundry, maintain a healthy environment
- Perform other related duties as requested.

WORK ENVIRONMENT:

• Considerable walking, standing, and moving of animals and supplies

- Employee will be required to have the physical strength to lift up to 50 lbs. and safely and effectively control large dogs
- The noise level in the work environment may be loud at times
- Exposed to toxic or caustic chemicals (cleaners, disinfectants and medical products) on a daily basis
